US 23	South from Columbus	55 miles south of I-270, bear right on OH-104. You will see a large Fred's Pizza and McDonald's sign on your left at the intersection. Waverly is your last chance for gas and is also your last stop for beer or wine. Adams County is dry! Check out Ozzies for craft beers, it's just over Crooked Creek on your right before the OH-104 turn off.
OH 104	Right (southwest)	It's exactly 6 miles on OH-104 to OH-32 west. It's a beautiful drive as you pass Lake White.
OH 32	Turn Right (west)	Enjoy the scenic <i>James A. Rhodes Appalachian Highway</i> west toward Cincinnati for 22.4 miles to Steam Furnace Rd.
Steam Furnace Rd.	Turn Left (south)	Now it gets fun! It is exactly 5 miles south to Fawcett Rd. You'll pass the Black Diamond, a great stop for a sandwich. They have a few basic supplies, 1 old-fashioned gas pump and all 7 varieties of Mountain Dew. Stop in and say 'Hi' to Julie the owner.
Fawcett Rd.	Turn Left (west)	It is 0.3 miles to Cedar Mills. At Cedar Mills bear right.
Cedar Mills Rd	Bear Right (south)	Enjoy this road for 3.1 miles, to Route 348
Rt. 348	Turn Right (west)	Nice road...too bad you might only be on it for 0.4 miles. Continue below based on experience, time of day and weather conditions.

For the adventurous...

In 0.4 miles, take your first left (south) on **Randall's Run**.

Be careful! There are no edge or lane lines from here on out, lot's of tight, blind curves, hidden drives and animals both wild and domestic.

In 0.3 miles, you will come to a fork, **bear right** up the hill onto **Bethany Ridge**. This is one of the most scenic roads I have ever driven. Enjoy slowly for 2.9 miles to St. Rt. 125.

St Rt 125, turn left (east) you are only on this for 75 yards. Take an **immediate right** (south) on **Hamilton Rd**.

Go 1.9 miles to **Kathy Lane**. Pass the farmhouse complex on your left then slow down. Kathy Lane is two gravel strips marked by a 2x4 on a stick with the word "Kathy" routed into it.

Kathy Lane: Over the bridge, follow the split rail fence and **bear left at the pole**, pass the "No ATV" sign and the metal swing gate. There is a small house on the right, that's Linda and Orville.

Believe it or not, Kathy Lane continues, but you will turn left up the hill to the cabin and you are here!

In case of bad weather or night driving...

Continue on Rt 348 for 4.6 miles.

Turn left (east) on to **St Rt. 125** east.

In 3.7 miles, **turn right** (south) on **Hamilton Rd**.

Go 1.9 miles to **Kathy Lane**. Pass the farmhouse complex on your left then slow down. Kathy Lane is two gravel strips marked by a 2x4 on a stick with the word "Kathy" routed into it.

Continue with the **Kathy Lane** details on the left.

This is about 5 miles longer, but infinitely safer as there are lane lines and edge markers.
